## Introduction

Astrology is an ancient science perhaps as old as measured time itself. But for centuries there has been a misunderstanding concerning the nature of astrology to the effect that the heavens somehow "influence" events on Earth. This theory has penetrated the modern world until today it is the main concept or idea of astrology supported by the public. Neither one is the cause of the other; both are the product of the moment, one acted out in the heavens above, and the other on Earth below.

While astrologers do not feel that heavenly events are the *cause* of events on Earth, they do believe that specific heavenly events are enacted here on Earth too -- at the same moment. In other words, the great drama enacted in the sky is also acted out here on Earth in the same instant. Another way to say this is that the Earth is part of the cosmos and shares in that cosmic moment. Astrologers tend to think that major cosmic events are interactive; they represent an activity also taking place within our consciousness.

In summary, astrology is the study of Energetics and the connection between cosmic events and how they are reflected in our earthly environment. Astrologers find the cosmic patterns revealed in the rhythmic motions of the planets a great help in shedding light on the seeming helter-skelter and contradiction of everyday life.

We hope you enjoy your **Character Portrait** . It has been calculated using sophisticated astronomical formulae to ensure high accuracy. You may find that parts of your report seem contradictory -- but this is normal. The planets do not neatly line up one after the other, but make different aspects to each other simultaneously. # **Planet Aspects**

## **The Lights: The Sun and Moon**

The planets, according to their configurations and relationships to each other at the time of our birth, tell us something about the special qualities each of us carries within. Each of the planets circling around the Sun represents different facets of our nature. Yet, of all the planets, the two most important ones to astrologers are the "lights," the Sun and the Moon. From where we stand on Earth, the great Sun by day and the reflecting Moon at night are our constant companions. And they have things to tell us as to where we have been and where we are headed.

## **The Sun: Your Self and Future**

In the same way that the Sun is at the center of the solar system, so in astrology the Sun forms the center of our personality, coloring the many other facets of our nature. The Sun represents our will and our deepest identity, or sense of self, in that it is toward these that we are moving and developing. Thus, it also represents that which we strive towards and will become: our goals and ambitions, older people, authorities -- those we look toward, or up to, our potential, and our future.

With the Sun in Taurus, you are patient, practical and persistent. Although you seem quiet and mild-mannered on the outside, you nonetheless possess a steady, unwavering determination. You are extremely reliable and motivated, particularly where money is the ultimate regard. More than most, you are driven to acquire the good things in life: material possessions, physical pleasures and comfort.

In your relations with others, you are kind and gentle, with a sympathetic ear, generally ready to help with an encouraging word or some sound practical advice. ### **The Moon: The Support System**

*Moon Opposition Venus*

**The Inner Planets: Mercury and Venus**

The planets Mercury and Venus have more to do with our internal and personal life than with life outside us. These inner planets are located between the orbit of the Earth and the Sun. We can look to qualities that are inside us. Venus indicates how we appreciate and measure our experience, how we value life. Mercury tells us something about how our mind works, how we think and communicate -- our intrinsic brightness.

**Mercury: The Mind and Communication**

Mercury rules communication and thus represents thoughts, ideas, and our mental processes. Mercury rules connections too -- by telephone, letter, and the spoken word: everything that connects and conveys, including our conversations. It also governs trade and commerce. Mercury's placement in our chart indicates how we think, reason, learn and communicate.



You have a sharp tongue and a quick wit. You speak first, and then think about it. Not subtle or complex, you are direct, simple, and to the point. An independent thinker, you would rather speak than listen. Argumentative too. You are quite impulsive when it comes to communicating, and often use strong words.

*Mercury in Aries*

**Venus: Values and Discrimination**

The placement of Venus in our chart shows how we relate and co-operate with others, and our attitude toward love and romance.

In love you are loyal, constant, gentle, sensuous, and you deeply enjoy all the physical expressions of love with your partner. You love to touch. Dependability and predictability in a relationship is a necessity for you -- you like to feel settled and will resist change. You do not like to be pushed where relationships are concerned and your lover should be patient and allow you plenty of time to make up your mind. You can also be very possessive. You are down-to-earth and are fond of a good home life, food, and all the creature comforts: you would probably enjoy gardening. Money and

### **The External Planets: Mars, Jupiter, Saturn**

The major planets outside the Earth's orbit (external to us) are Mars, Jupiter, and Saturn. These are the planets of the outer world -- life as we find it outside ourselves. Mars tells us something about the drive and energy we have, Jupiter shows us how to best channel that energy, and Saturn decrees what sort of material or territory we will be passing through. Again: Saturn tells us about the territory we will be going through, Jupiter the way or path through it, and Mars what kind of push or drive we can count on to keep going.

### **Mars: Drive and Emotions**

The fiery planet Mars governs our energy, will, inner motivation or drive, and our sexuality. Its placement in our chart indicates where our courage lies, our aggression, our ability to be assertive, to defend our ego -- to survive. Mars urges us on to achieve: it also drives us against things, sending us into war and combat. The placement of Mars determines much concerning our sexuality and libido.

You possess a powerful, persistent drive and are a hard, steady worker. Others may find you deep, with a sense of mission and mystery. You are willing to do work others would not go near, quietly bending things to your will, having it your own way. You have strong sexual energy, too, and enjoy getting down to the nitty-gritty.

*Mars in Scorpio*

Your drive and ambition may tend to be counterproductive or work against your own best interest at times. You may feel challenged and competitive with authority

figures. Your feelings and emotions can get out of control and go against your will.

***Sun Opposition Mars***

***Moon Conjunction Mars***

***Venus Opposition Mars***

The perfect manager: conservative and professional in all things. Your career is all-important. A "doer," you are always practical. Never ruled by emotions, you are cool, capable, and competent. You are quick to get the outline or skeleton of a project, to see how things work.

***Jupiter in Capricorn***

You were born lucky in many respects! You are a natural when it comes to finding the pot of gold at the end of the rainbow, and are very generous with others -- you love to spread good things around. You possess a natural talent for finding your way past the pitfalls of life. You have a need to travel and to socialize.

You demand a lot from yourself, and from others too, so much so that you may sometimes overwhelm others with the intensity of your approach. ### **The Outer Planets**

In the previous sections, we have dealt with planets that we can see with our naked eyes. In general, these planets refer to life as we know and live it and are the so-called historical or classic planets. Beyond these are three planets that are not visible in the sky and which have cycles longer than the average human life span. Since they are beyond Saturn or time, astrologers call them the trans-personal or transcendental planets -- the planets beyond the physical: Uranus, Neptune, and Pluto.

#### **Uranus: Break-Thrus & Insights**

Uranus is associated with innovation, originality, unconventionality, and the quest for freedom. Its influence in our chart can manifest as both creative genius, and rebel. Its placement indicates our area of unique self-expression, and the ways in which we break with convention. It is through Uranus that we have sudden insights into things and can come to know and understand ourselves better. It rules invention and has to do with finding new uses for old things: everything that is unusual, eccentric and out of the ordinary, this is Uranus. Aspects to Uranus also indicate the way we express our need for higher consciousness.

You have new philosophical ideas for the future and new approaches to travel and exploration of all kinds. Long journeys interest you. You may startle others with your direct conversation, always getting right to the nitty-gritty of any matter. You enjoy being alone, free, and on the move. You are the original optimist.

#### ***Uranus in Sagittarius***

You may have a history of conflict with authority figures, including your parents and boss. Some may see you as a bit of a revolutionary. Where your job is concerned you find it difficult to maintain habitual schedules. Your work habits tend to be unusual or erratic, and you would probably achieve the most satisfaction in life by being self-employed. Your difficulties may find you moving around a lot -- establishing a firm foundation in your life may seem out of reach. Nonetheless, you would do well to learn the art of compromise and giving in at times, and try to bring more permanence into your life: for it is in a more secure environment that you are best able to develop your skills and talents. Neptune can bring selfless service to others, but in our weakness and the process of self-understanding, it can also bring confusion, selfishness, dishonesty and addiction. The secret of reaping its benefits lies in the sharing of the gifts it bestows with others.

The practical is the ideal. Form follows function. You have a dream of being in control -- the puppet master. You are very interested in tradition and tend to be dignified and conservative. You believe in an orderly society led by benevolent monarchs -- those who can see what to do.

#### ***Neptune in Capricorn***

You possess remarkable psychological talent -- able to sense and feel in the more abstract mental areas and to bring far-out ideas down to earth. You are always at the leading edge of social understanding, and have a great sense of compassion and a real understanding of others.

#### ***Mercury Trine Neptune***

## **Landscape: Major Life Periods**

## **Interface: Innermost qualities**

## **Major Transits Happening Now**

Astrologers use the term "transits" to mean the positions of the major planets that are overhead (in the sky) right now and their relationship to our birth chart. Transits are very important indicators of the current situation in which we find ourselves. They can provide insight into what we are now going through. Here are the dates when the next major transits for the planets Jupiter, Saturn, Uranus, Neptune, and Pluto are exact in your chart. Some dates will have already passed and some are still to come. Remember, with these large planets transits don't just happen on the day when they are exact. They cover a wide span of days, weeks, months, and sometimes years, depending on which planet is involved.

In general, transits of Jupiter take from several days to a week or two to complete, while those of Saturn take from two weeks to a month to play themselves out. With the outer planets, the period of activity is even longer: transits of Uranus take about two months, Neptune three or four months, and Pluto takes about a year. Uranus, Neptune, and Pluto move so slowly that the complete transit experience may take a year or two to complete itself. So be prepared to work with these situations.

## **House Activity and Emphasis**

The twelve houses of your birth chart, most especially when occupied by one or more planets, (*which may or may not be the case*) provide insight into areas of special activity and the way in which we use them. Here follows an analysis of house activity based on planet emphasis:

### **First House: Appearance, Approach**

The first house, also referred to as the Ascendant or Rising Sign, has to do with how we interact with the world, the way we appear and come across. Thus it has to do with our appearance and personality, our physical constitution, and our mannerisms. It is the way we spontaneously present ourselves to others, and what they perceive to be our essential temperament. This house rules our personal self and everything about us that draws a reaction from our surroundings or others -- how we are accepted in social situations.

*First House*

Virgo energy is analytical and precise, always separating what is worthwhile and worth supporting from that which is outmoded and of no further use. This is a mental sign, where thinking and examining are in high focus. Always compassionate and responsive, Virgo energy is service-oriented above all, often thinking and caring more about what others are doing and thinking than for self.

### **Second House: Possessions, Reactions**

The second house is concerned with our personal resources, what we own and what we value. This house indicates how we have and hold things -- our possessions, material goods, money, and the like. It shows our attitudes toward these things: how we go about obtaining them, and how and if we keep them. This house refers to how we make ourselves secure, and the kind of response we get from life and those around us in these matters. It is also an indication of our sense of values and self-worth apart from our orientation in the material world.

*Second House*

Libra energy is always facilitating and responsive, assuming the appropriate reaction or response to any question or statement. What is sometimes seen as two-faced is only Libra's facility at responding to each in kind. This is certainly the social sign, par excellence. Impersonal and impartial, this sign doles out only what is demanded, never overdoing things.

Security and protection are important issues for you. You are ambitious and prepared to work hard to obtain material security for yourself; in fact, when choosing a job or career the level of long-term security it offers may be a determining factor. This road, however, may be fraught with obstacles and it may be difficult -- though not impossible -- for you to achieve your material goals. You would make a shrewd business person; and can be frugal when it comes to personal possessions, limiting your purchases to what is essential or has lasting value. A tendency to become miserly should be watched with this placement of Saturn. Emotionally you may have difficulty expressing affection or sentiment.

Resourceful where making money is concerned, you could be a terrific businessperson, as you have an ability to get past the surface of things and root out the things of worth. This placement of Pluto will increase any other drive for acquiring material resources in your chart, and endow you with an ability to gain from opportunities that others may overlook. Research or mining projects could prove

profitable. Beware any tendency to gain wealth using unethical methods. In the area of possessions or material goods you will go through a lot of changes, thus learning a great deal from your experiences.

**Third House: Inquiries, Communications**

The third house is concerned with our communications, our immediate surroundings, and the way in which we react to these. It rules connections, everyday communication, and transportation: wires, letters, telephones, exploration, investigation, inquiry, questioning, and research of all kinds, plus short journeys such as everyday travel to work or to shop. This is a mental house and rules our mental aptitudes, early education, and training skills. This house also governs siblings, neighbors, and those who form part of our daily lives.

*Third House*

Scorpio is intense, passionate, and very personal. Scorpio rushes past superficialities and right to the heart of any matter. A loyal friend but a fanatic foe, this sign does well in politics and all areas where someone who dares is rewarded. Often associated with sexual energy, perhaps due to its tendency to strip away veneer and lay bare, anything that is there.

*Scorpio*

You probably lead a busy life full of change and fluctuation. Indeed, you would not enjoy a life of dull routine, preferring to be on the move, keeping your mind occupied. Mentally you collect a large amount of miscellaneous facts and detail, however, there is a risk that knowledge will become too superficial and of little practical use. To improve the art of communication and make it more realistic you must make efforts to improve mental concentration.

You are prone to fantasy and daydreams, however, if you apply yourself and exert control over your imagination, your creative reservoir could be put to use in poetry or music. You probably have a good memory, which is recalled in images. You have a studious bent and history, archaeology, and ideas relating to the past may interest you.

*Moon in Third House*

You have a relentless drive to pursue knowledge, to search, research and follow out leads and pointers. You are very motivated when it comes to communications of all forms -- telephone, voice, letters, computers, and the like. There is a need to curb impulsive thinking -- which could cause problems -- and develop more an ability for analytical thinking. Work that requires moving around,

such as research, driving, teaching, trading is the best use of your abundant energy. Many short journeys are a strong possibility in your life. In childhood you may have been subject to a discordant environment involving siblings that has left you with a tendency to be somewhat nervous or highly-strung.

***Mars in Third House***

This placement gives you very sharp perceptions. You have remarkable insight in areas connected to research, study, and the world of ideas. You quickly absorb and analyze information from your environment, perceiving subtle nuances that others do not notice. This talent enables you to get a very complete picture of a situation, which you are able to convey clearly and intelligently to others: where information is lacking your exceptional intuitive ability usually accurately fills in any gaps.

You tend to want to break free of programmed ways of thinking and conditioning, whether from your upbringing or those imposed by society. Your thinking is oriented toward the future. Your independent mental approach to problem solving and communication finds you coming up with connections that are new and different.

***Uranus in Third House***

**Fourth House: Home, Family, Security**

The fourth house governs our parental background and home, and later our domestic conditions, home and family life: where we send down roots, seek nourishment and generally seek to make ourselves secure and settle down. This house represents the base from which we can work, feel, experience, and take care of our loved ones and ourselves: thus it represents the very root of our experience, and how we feel about and relate to these things. The fourth house governs the place where we live and real estate in general.

***Fourth House***

Sagittarius is nothing if not direct, candid, and to the point. Sometimes harsh, this energy always is concerned with the absolute truth of the subject at hand. Associated with philosophy, religion, and all things that last, Sagittarius energy is always welcome in politics as well as social and community endeavors, where its basic fairness and evenhandedness is helpful.

***Sagittarius***

You are quite hedonistic and probably have a lot of friends. Both friends and family are very important to you and you have a strong sense of roots, loyalty, and devotion where home and family are concerned. You are likely to gain much from

your parent's influence throughout your life, and will enjoy many social and educational advantages. You enjoy life's comforts, and the latter part of your life is likely to be full and fortunate, and will include travel and study.

Your career may be built on your search for roots and security. You find yourself through your home and family interests -- all things domestic -- and it would be excellent if you could somehow make your living in these areas. You really need a larger than normal home -- or one with a marvellous view -- or you may feel claustrophobic. Your mood is generally hopeful, confident and expansive, and you have a certain faith in your own inner guidance.

#### ***Jupiter in Fourth House***

You are probably very sensitive to your home environment, and emotional ties to family life are strong. Family, home, and domestic security seem very important to you, and it is in this area that you seek the ideal life. You may be very imaginative and creative where your home and domestic setup is concerned; or a sense of community and unity pervades your family life. On the other hand, you are likely to have experienced some kind of sacrifice in connection with your home, or perhaps with a parent. A family secret, an unusual parent, or even "skeleton in the closet" is a possibility. If home life has been unhappy there may be a tendency to withdraw somewhat from life in general. However, a challenge exists that requires you to live life in accordance more with reality -- no matter how harsh it seems -- and to develop an inner security based on a knowledge of the way things really are, and not according to your imagination of how they should be. People with this placement often play a musical instrument, and if this does not apply to you, there may be a latent talent for this that should be discovered and nurtured. As you grow older you may become more reclusive and find you harbor a desire to live by the sea.

### **Fifth House: Expression, Creativity**

The fifth house has to do with creation, procreation, and recreation. Thus it governs our personal creative expression and pursuits; romance, courtship, lovemaking and children: the way we play and amuse ourselves, including gambling and speculation. All forms of expression are connected to this house -- offspring, animals, creative self-expression as in art, acting, athletics, craftsmanship, dancing, music, poetry, writing, and so on. This house also represents how you enjoy and appreciate these things in others, and all that is your emotional or heart's desire.

#### ***Fifth House***

Capricorn is the business energy of the zodiac, for it is the very opposite of the emotional Cancer. Given to clear-headedness and practical insight and vision, this sign always takes a distanced perspective, a cool appraisal. Logical and painstaking, Capricorns love hard work and earned results. Money and things in general are very important.

#### ***Capricorn***

**Sixth House: Responsibility, Work, Health**

The sixth house is concerned with duty, health and service. Thus it concerns the way in which we take care of our everyday lives -- bill-paying, chores, efficiency, responsibilities, organization, how we work at making a living and take care of business. It denotes our ability to separate the wheat from the chaff. It governs how we care for others, and ourselves, and thus our daily health, stress management, and nutrition. This house is also associated with areas such as servants, pets, and also the ways in which we render service to others.

***Sixth House***

Aquarius: the sign of humanitarian goals and altruism. Always impartial and nonsectarian, Aquarian energy is communal, and even global. The focus is on the goal, and the goal is always one that is for the many and not the few. Thus this sign is connected to far-seeing visions, worldviews, and group work of all kinds. This sign tends towards coolness, independence.

***Aquarius*****Seventh House: Relationships, Other People**

The seventh house is the house of partnerships, relationships, and co-operation with others. Thus it is the house of marriage, one-to-one relationships, of business partners, and also the house of adversaries, open enemies, and those who oppose us. Its placement in our chart indicates how we relate in one-to-one relationships, how we deal with our needs and those of others, and how we fare with our competitors and opponents. Relationships in this domain include those with doctors, lawyers, therapists, counselors, consultants, and such.

***Seventh House***

Pisces energy runs deep and toward the psychological -- whatever is beneath the surface. This sign is understanding, patient, and long-suffering. Pisces tend to absorb all the little barbs and digs coming from outside. They always have their mind on an inner goal, something more important. They are very forgiving and accepting -- giving of themselves for the sake of more important issues.

***Pisces*****Eighth House: Business Savvy, Elimination**

The eighth house rules death, sex, financial dealings with others, joint finances and resources, inheritances, taxes, transformation, regeneration, and our fears and self-mastery. Thus it represents how we share with others, how we deal with other

people's resources and money, and our merging with things greater than ourselves. It is the house of our deepest feelings and how we get in touch with them. It is associated with endings and beginnings, which includes letting go of things we are most identified with in order that renewal -- new levels of independence and freedom -- can occur.

### *Eighth House*

Aries is the sign of the pioneer and leader. It is impulsive and spontaneous, acting first and thinking about what has been done later. Rushing in where others fear to tread, the Aries energy is attention getting. It always provokes a response from the surroundings, from others. There is something essential and instigative in its energy that starts or causes something else to happen -- a reaction or response.

### *Aries*

You have a very analytical bent, and your mind excels at making practical decisions. Finances, taxes, insurance, and other areas pertaining to the resources of others may interest you. However, your mind runs deeper than practical or superficial issues, which could also mean an interest in the deeper issues of life, depth psychology and even occult and mystical subjects. You are a natural born investigator, always able to get to the truth of a situation. An interest in human behaviour may find you connected with study or investigation in such fields.

### *Mercury in Eighth House*

You greatly enjoy your physical comforts and probably have a tendency toward inertia. Self-discipline does not come easily to you. You come across as quietly intense in social situations. In romantic relationships you may tend toward possessiveness or jealousy. You do not care much for the superficial. You appreciate getting past the surface of things to the heart, the bare bones of the matter. This could make you a very shrewd and discriminating businessperson. You are likely to inherit money during your life, possibly through marriage or relatives.

### *Venus in Eighth House*

## **Ninth House: Religions, Philosophy, Ideas**

The ninth house rules philosophy, religion, higher education, long journeys, spiritual truths, and the higher mind. Thus this house governs our relationship to the higher meaning and purpose of life. It shows how we learn about life through travel, connections with foreign lands and cultures; and how we open our minds and tolerate differing viewpoints and traditions to our own. This house represents our sense of ourselves, beyond and above the confines and labels of society. It beckons us to understand the connections between things and to express our utmost integrity. This house also represents our teachers and mentors in life and everything that



broadens our outlook. The presence of natal planets in this house will heighten and deepen the philosophical nature.

***Ninth House***

Taurus manages to respond, possess, and "have" just about everything possible. This is a nurturing and fertile sign in that any seed or impulse is cradled, bringing forth growth and development. Taurus is the way we "have" things, how we possess and acquire things. There is something gentle, regular, steadfast, and determined about Taurus: always accepting, nurturing, and providing a base where growth can take place.

***Taurus***

With your noble nature the focus of your life will be on the ideal and much less on practical concerns. You have a direct and candid side to your nature and tend to brush past appearances to the truth within. You are good at seeing the overview and express your ideas on a lofty plain, although your thoughts often lack practicality. Ideas from higher mind, law, philosophy, religion, spirituality, and higher education will be life long interests, and will tend to govern your life. A yearn to travel to foreign lands will be stronger in you than in most people. You may find yourself counseling, and being a teacher to others.

***Sun in Ninth House*****Tenth House: Practical Vision, Vocation**

The tenth house, also called the Midheaven, rules our profession, career, job, public image, our reputation and status, and our accomplishments. Thus this house shows what our aims are and how we go about fulfilling them: what we do for a living, how we make a personal contribution to society through our talents and gifts, what we are known for and how the world sees us, in both our accomplishments and our failures. The tenth house also indicates the things we do for personal satisfaction and not just monetary concerns, our life's work or hobbies.

***Tenth House***

Gemini is concerned with connections and communication of all kinds -- letters, wires, telephones, voice, thoughts, writing, and mental processes in general. Gemini is the gadfly, the communicator, and the gossip of the zodiac. Searching conversations, scientific inquiry, research, and so on belong here. Gemini energy is unattached, independent, and inquisitive.

***Gemini***

**Eleventh House: Dreams & Visions, Community**

The eleventh house rules group consciousness, organizations, social circles, and intellectual pleasure. Thus this house is connected with altruistic and humanitarian goals and our ability to achieve our ideals. It is the house of friends and community, and represents the vision we share with everyone, our sense of the common good. This house placement in our chart is an indication of the ideals we try to live by, our attitudes toward society and how we approach social situations and interact with groups. It represents our friends and associates -- the ones we choose to spend time with --and the organizations we join. It can be an indication of how we relate to community service, our political ideals, and philanthropic effort.

***Eleventh House***

Cancer is the mother of the zodiac, always making a home, protecting and providing for others. This is a sensitive sign where feelings and real experience count more than cold logic. It does not get any more physical and emotional than here. This sign has a sense of substance, a home base or foundation. Cancer energy is always limiting, bringing us down to Earth, and grounding our every thought in experience, in substance.

***Cancer*****Twelfth House: Sacrifice, Psychology, Acceptance**

The twelfth house is connected to self-undoing, hidden enemies, hospitals, prisons, institutions, and everything that confines us. It represents the "you" that is hidden. It reveals the ways in which we make sacrifices for our beliefs and to make our dreams manifest in the world around us -- for if not they are just blown away with a negative reaction. The problems that arise from the placement of this house in your chart can often be dealt with by helping others who are similarly confined, or repressed.

***Twelfth House***

Leo energy is expressive, emotive, and concerned with awareness and a sense of pride and ownership. Here is always a sense of home base or confidence from which the aggressive and outgoing Leo energy operates. Often very artistic, and always theatrical and expressive, this sign is good for creativity and the arts. Warm and big-hearted, this sign belongs to love of animals, sports, and children.

***Leo***
